CODE OF CONDUCT IN THE BEACH

In the beaches of As Catedrais and Os Castros-As Illas, it's forbidden along the whole year:

- Presence of motor boats, motorcycles, etc., except those belonging to the security and rescue service.
- Presence of pets (prohibition at Easter and from 15 May to 15 September)
- Deposit of waste and packaging in unauthorized places
- Making of camping
- Passage of unauthorized vehicles
- Use of detergents in outdoor showers
- Other annoying activities for other users (annoying noises, unauthorized sports practices ...).

SERVICES AVAILABLE FOR BEACH USERS

ACCESS	The main accesses to the beach are located on the N-634 road, in the A Devesa area, which is also accessed from the A-8 motorway. There is access to the sandy beach, not adapted, if being accessible all the beach environment. In Easter, July, August and September, free authorization is required to visit (https://ascatedrais.xunta.gal)	The main accesses to the beach are located on the N-634 road, in the A Devesa area, which is also accessed from the A-8 motorway. There are 3 accesses to the sand, 2 in Os Castros and 1 in As Illas, not adapted, if being accessible all the beach environment.
TOILETS, SHOWERS, FOOTBATHS	As Catedrais beach has 3 bathrooms, one of them adapted for people with reduced mobility. Public price of € 1.00 for the use of the toilets. Hours: 8 hours depending on the tide. The showers, fountains and footbaths located at the entrances are enabled.	In the access by ramps there are 4 toilets and 4 showers, as in the access by stairs. In the first aid and first aid stand located in the center of the walk there are 2 adapted toilets. Schedule toilets: from 11:30 to 19:30
SOCORRISM AND FIRST AID SERVICE	On the beaches of As Catedrais and Os Castros-As Illas there is a rescue and first aid team composed of one group leader, 11 lifeguards, 3 health technicians and Civil Protection volunteers, assisted by the Galician Health Service (SERGAS). The Health Center of Ribadeo has a Continuous Care Point 24 hours, located at Calle Reinante s / n, telephone 982130143, in which a medicalized ambulance is also available permanently. Service hours: from 11:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.	
INFORMATION POINT	The information point on As Catedrais beach is located at the main access to it. The opening hours are based on low tide. In addition, there is the Tourist Information Service in the urban area of the Ribadeo City Council, in the Plaza de España (Center of the Historic District) with hours from Monday to Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. in winter and from Monday to Sunday from 10 to 14 and from 16 to 20 in summer. LOCAL POLICE	The beaches of As Catedrais and Os Castros-As Illas will have police presence according to protocol defined by the local Police, from 11 to 20 hours from 15 June to 15 September. In other seasons (parties or special events), the minimums will be maintained.	
STAINLESS STEEL, CONTAINERS SELECTIVE COLLECTION	There is a daily cleaning service on the beaches of As Catedrais and Os Castros-As Illas, which cleans the surface of the beaches and their infrastructures and accesses. In addition, there are located bins and containers for the selective collection arranged in the main accesses, which are emptied daily.	
ANALYSIS OF WATER QUALITY	There is a service of analysis of the water realized every 15 days through the Xunta de Galicia, by means of which it is tried to carry out a monitoring of the bath waters of these beaches, obtaining a guarantee of quality. The results of these updated analyzes can be consulted in the information panels located in the main accesses of the beaches from 15 June to 15 September.

COMPLAINT AND SUGGESTIONS SYSTEM

There are sheets of complaints and complaints available to users of the beaches of As Catedrais and Os Castros-As Illas in the information points and in the rescue modules of the beaches. Also on the website of the City of Ribadeo and the Tourist Information Point there is a suggestion box for any idea that you want to contribute. In addition, within the quality system belonging to these beaches, there are records for incidents and nonconformities detected daily on the beaches.

OBJECTIVES ESTABLISHED 2023

- OBJECTIVE No. 1: Reduce fuel consumption on the beaches by 5%.

Result: The objective is more than met, achieving a reduction of 64.46% in As Catedrais and 59.02% in Os Castros-As Illas.

NEW OBJECTIVES ESTABLISHED 2024

- OBJECTIVE No. 1: Improvement of the beach environment.

COMMITMENTS ACQUIRED BY THE RIBADEO CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of Ribadeo acquired commitments of both quality and environmental management that are reflected in the beach and environmental management policies approved by the local government board and which are exposed to the public.
